\*2 Such offenses include:

- Felony trafficking of persons for labor or sexual servitude as prohibited by O.C.G.A. § 16-5-46;
- Neglecting disabled adults, elder persons, or residents as prohibited by O.C.G.A. § 16-5-101;
- Exploitation and intimidation of disabled adults, elder persons, and residents as prohibited by O.C.G.A. § 16-5-102;
- Any of the following when committed against a law enforcement officer while the officer is engaged in the performance of his/her official duties:
  - Felony aggravated assault in violation of O.C.G.A. § 16-5-21;
  - Felony aggravated battery in violation of O.C.G.A. § 16-5-24;

\*3 Such offenses include:

- A violation of O.C.G.A. § 16-5-70 (Cruelty to Children);
- A violation of O.C.G.A. § 16-6-4 (Child Molestation);
- A violation of O.C.G.A. § 16-6-5 (Enticing a child for indecent purposes);
- A violation of O.C.G.A. § 16-6-5.1 (Improper sexual contact);
- A violation of O.C.G.A. § 30-5-8 (Failing to make a report of abuse, neglect, or exploitation of disabled adults and elder persons);
- A felony violation of:
  - Chapter 5, 6, 8, 9 or 13 of Title 16 of the Georgia Code;
  - O.C.G.A. § 16-4-1 (Criminal attempt);
  - O.C.G.A. § 16-7-2 (Smash and grab burglary); or
  - Subsection (f) of O.C.G.A. 31-7-12.1 (Owning or operating an unlicensed personal care home that is dangerous to the public health, safety, and welfare).
- Any other offense committed in another jurisdiction which, if committed in Georgia, would constitute one of the above offenses without regard to its designation elsewhere.
