## **NEIGHBORHOOD SCHOOL**

34 C.F.R. 300.116(B)(3)

Under IDEA, the educational placement of a student with a disability must be "as close as possible to a child's home."

## SAME ASSIGNMENT AS PEERS

#### 34 C.F.R. 300.116 (C)

"Unless the IEP of a child with a disability requires some other arrangement, the child [must be] educated in the school that he or she would attend if nondisabled."



## SECTION 504 & PROXIMITY

34 C.F.R. 104.34 (A)

"Whenever a recipient places a person in a setting other than the regular educational environment...it shall take into account the proximity of the alternate setting to the person's home."

## CENTRALIZED SERVICES

#### **RESOURCE-INTENSIVE & SPECIALIZED SUPPORT**

School districts have significant authority to provide certain services at a centralized location without violating the IDEA or Section 504.



#### TRANSFER DECISIONS



#### SIMPLE MODIFICATION OR DUPLICATE RESOURCE

Proper implementation of a student's IEP should guide the transfer decision. Districts may consider program advantages, travel time and costs of making neighborhood school equally suitable.
